## **1 PURPOSE**

The purpose of this document is to meet security requirements regarding University anti-virus software.

## **2 SCOPE**

The standard set in this document will apply to the following types of computer systems amongst the University:

- Deskside systems including all lab systems
- All end user systems
- Servers

## **3 STANDARD**

All user and server systems that utilize the University network are required to have a supported and current version of anti-virus in order to perform due diligence towards protecting University systems. It is encouraged that systems not owned by the University utilize University endorsed anti-virus to ensure that proper assistance can be obtained should issues regarding the anti-virus arise. Systems that are owned by the University should utilize University endorsed anti-virus. Consistency in software will allow for a stronger support base for possible end users.

## **4 ENFORCEMENT**

Those systems found utilizing the University network will be removed from the network immediately and asked to install the appropriate anti-virus solution. Upon installation of the proper anti-virus solution, the system will again be allowed access the network.

## **5 STANDARD SAFEGUARDING**
